


WHAT IS MEDICAL MALPRACTICE?

Medical malpractice occurs when a medical professional - doctors, nurses, etc. - provide care that diverges from what is accepted as standard or reasonable care. Medical malpractice might mean that a doctor makes mistakes or acts in an unreasonable manner and causes a patient harm.
